

Official Call of the Mass Meeting of the Richmond County Republican Party

As Chairman of the Richmond County Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia, and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Debra L Harper, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Warsaw Town Office, 78 Belleville Lane, Warsaw, VA 22572, starting at 7:00 PM, registration starting at 6:45 PM local time on Monday, March 29, 2010 for the following purposes:

- 1) Electing a Chairman
- 2) Electing members to the Richmond County Republican Committee
- 3) Electing up to thirty-five (35) Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the First Congressional District Republican Convention to be held on May 15, 2010 at the Caroline County High School, 19155 Rogers Clark Blvd., Milford, VA. 25514, beginning at 1:00 PM local time for the purpose of electing a Chairman for the First District Congressional Committee. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Richmond County is entitled to 7 Delegate Votes, and
- 4) Transacting other business as may properly come before the Committee

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Richmond County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party after March 1, 2004, or in the last five years, whichever is more recent.

A single exception to this shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception thereafter.

A person who has made application for registration and meets all other requirements of the Qualifications for Participation, but whose name does not appear on the local registration books solely because of the books having been closed in connection with a local election, will nevertheless be deemed a legal and qualified voter.

Participation and Filing Requirements

Candidates for election as Delegates or Alternates to the First Congressional District Convention, Chairman of the Committee or members of the Richmond County Republican Committee shall file a written statement, using the official pre-filing form, by mail or in person with the Chairman of the Richmond County Republican Committee, Debra L Harper, 6029 Newland Road, Warsaw, Va. 22572. Forms must be received not later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 22, 2010. Postmarks do not govern. Forms may be obtained by contacting the Chairman by mail, email, telephone or in person or may be downloaded at www.rpv.org or northernneckrepublicans.org; (804)-366-4989.

All candidates seeking membership in the Richmond County Committee are required to submit a \$10.00 filing fee, made payable to the Richmond County Republican Committee.

Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee to participate in this Mass Meeting. No fee is required to attend the First Congressional District Republican Convention, but a voluntary donation of \$10 is requested. A photo ID will be required at registration for the First District Convention
